

PROCEDURES FOR ANNUAL MEETING

When speaking, the speaker should address the issue. All qualified ELECTORS (registered voters of Oak Park Township) will be allowed to speak before any non-residents are recognized.

When an elector speaks or makes a motion, he/she should identify himself and his registered Oak Park address.

When a non-resident speaks, it will be solely at the discretion of the moderator.

Once an elector has spoken, he/she will not be recognized a second time until any other elector wishing to speak has been heard. The second time an elector speaks, he/she will be doing so at the moderator's discretion.

RESOLUTIONS TO COME BEFORE THE ELECTORS:

RESOLUTION RE: PROPERTY RECORD SYSTEM

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Electors of the Town of Oak Park in the County of Cook, State of Illinois, that the Town Board of Trustees is authorized to expend monies for the preparation, establishment and maintenance of a detailed property record system which would provide information useful to assessment officials and to enter into contracts with persons, firms, or corporations for the preparation and establishment of such record system pursuant to 60 ILCS 1/30-45.

RESOLUTION FOR SETTING THE TIME FOR THE 2022 ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Electors of the Town of Oak Park in the County of Cook, State of Illinois, that the 2022 Annual Town Meeting of the Town of Oak Park be set for April 12, 2022 at 6:30 p.m.

RESOLUTION RE: AUTHORIZATION TO SELL SURPLUS PROPERTY ITEMS

WHEREAS, Oak Park Township is a unit of local government organized and existing pursuant to the Township Code as set forth in 60 ILCS 1/1-1 et seq; and

WHEREAS, the Township possesses property that is no longer useful or valuable to the Township; and

WHEREAS, 60 ILCS 1/30-50 of the Township Code governs the disposition of Township property; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to dispose of the property in accordance with said statute.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ELECTORS OF THE OAK PARK TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That Township property having a sale value of less than \$200, is hereby declared surplus.

SECTION 2: That the surplus property be disposed of in accordance with Section 1/30-50 of the Township Code 60 ILCS 1/30-50.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
