

**OAK PARK TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE NO. 2022-01**

Abating the amount of additional tax created by and added to taxes previously levied for the year 2021 from the passage of PA 102-0519 effective August 2021, of the Oak Park Township, Cook County, Illinois.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the “Board”) of the Oak Park Township, Cook County, Illinois (the “Township”), by Ordinance Number 2021-02, adopted on the 16th day of November, 2021 (the “Ordinance”), did provide for the levy of a direct annual tax sufficient to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law (the “levy”); and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Board that the amounts levied (as defined in the Ordinance) are or will be available to pay all the anticipated necessary expenses and liabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Board further determines that it is necessary and in the best interests of the Township that the any taxes added to the amounts in this levy in connection with PA 102-0519 be abated in their entirety:

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of Oak Park Township, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The Board hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2. Abatement of Tax. That any additional tax created by and added to this levy in connection with PA 102-0519 for the year 2021 is hereby abated in its entirety.

Section 3. Filing of Ordinance. Forthwith upon the adoption of this Ordinance, the Town Clerk shall file a certified copy hereof with the County Clerk of Cook County, Illinois, and it shall be the duty of said County Clerk to abate the any

additional amount of taxes created by PA 102-0519 for the year 2021 in accordance with the provisions hereof.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.
